

Lansing Area Swim & Water Play Locations

Hawk Island Beach and Splash Pad

Located in Lansing, Hawk Island boasts a 30-acre lake, including a sandy beach, bath house, and Splash Pad. Hawk Island also has a handicap accessible asphalt path encompassing the entire lake that is perfect for a leisurely stroll along the lake. The beach at Hawk Island is open from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend from 12:00pm to 8:00pm seven days a week. The beach is only open when weather permits and lifeguards are on duty.



The Splash Pad at Hawk Island is a zero depth water park with fifteen features to spray, splash, and dump a blast of refreshing cool water! Located adjacent to the beach house, with lounge chairs and chaise lounges. Children under 12 should have adult supervision. Open Memorial Day through Labor Day 9:00am to 8:00pm weather permitting and is free of charge. If it rains, the Splash Pad is non-operational. 1601 E Cavanaugh Rd.

Burchfield Park Beach

Burchfield Park features 540 acres of scenic woods and trails and a swimming beach, located just 8 miles from downtown Lansing.



Along with a swimming beach, Burchfield Park also has a bath house. The beach at Burchfield Park is open only on weekends (Saturday and Sundays) and holidays from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend from 12:00pm to 8:00pm. The beach is only open when weather permits and lifeguards are on duty. The beach is closed for swimming or wading Monday-Friday due to budget cuts. 881 Grovenburg Rd, Holt.

Lake Lansing Park South Beach

Take a swim on a hot summer at Lake Lansing Park South. The park has a sandy beach, bath house, and snack bar and is only 7 miles from downtown Lansing located in Haslett. The beach at Lake Lansing Park South is open from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend from 12:00pm to 8:00pm seven days a week. The beach is only open when weather permits and lifeguards are on duty. 1621 Pike St, Haslett.



Hunter Park Pool & Splash Pad

Hunter Park pool and Splash Pad is very kid friendly. The pool is a large zero depth entry pool perfect for the smallest of children. A splash pad is located right off the pool and the deep end of the pool features a rock climbing wall. Opens late summer. Lifeguards are on duty. 1400 E. Kalamazoo, Lansing (between Pennsylvania and Clemons/Aurelius). 371-3622 (summer only).



Moore's Park Pool

The J. H. Moore's Memorial Natatorium is located in Moore's Park in Lansing near the bank of the Grand River. Showers and locker rooms are available. Moore's Pool has FREE open swim from 12-4 and 5-7 seven days a week, beginning June 17th and running until August 17th. Lifeguards on duty. 600 Moore's River Drive, Lansing - (between MLK and Washington). 371-2778 (summer only).



East Lansing Family Aquatic Center

Slide the water slides and swim in the pools at the East Lansing Family Aquatic Center. The center features three water slides, splash pad, toddler slide, zero entry pool with diving board and more. Concessions are available but food may also be brought in. The park is open 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. until July 31; then will be open 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily.

Admission is \$6 for East Lansing residents and \$9 for non-residents. Children under 2 years are free. 6400 Abbot Rd, East Lansing (located off Abbot, north of Lake Lansing Road). (517) 332-4420



Motz County Park

Amenities include a sand beach and swimming area, beachhouse with 7 unisex restrooms, paved walkways and parking lot, picnic tables, grills, fishing pier and a covered pavilion. A floating mobility chair is available upon request to a park ranger. Motz Park is completely handicap accessible.

The park is open from 8:00 a.m. to dusk daily with free admission and is located at 4630 N. DeWitt Road, St. Johns (north of Saint Johns between Colony and French roads on DeWitt road).



Valhalla Park

Valhalla features a wooded area, open fields, a pond, and a lake, all of which are used to provide diverse year round recreation.

During the summer months, a beach and swimming are the focal points of the park. Next to this area are bathrooms and changing rooms. Adjacent to the beach is a large, semi-wooded, picnic area and a new playground that was finished in 2009. Other warm weather facilities include three softball diamonds, a nature trail, and fishing areas on both the lake and the pond. A large group picnic pavilion is also available on a rental basis. Corner of Keller and Pine Tree Roads in Holt.



Sleepy Hollow State Park

Sleepy Hollow State Park contains over 2,600 acres including a river winding its way through the woods, fields and trails. Lake Ovid nestled in the middle of it all was developed by damming the Little Maple River and covers 410-acres. Over 900 yards of additional sand in 2009 and 2011. Modern bathrooms. 2 shelters available for rent or use on a first come, first serve basis. The park offers year-round opportunity for recreation. 7835 E. Price Road, Laingsburg.
