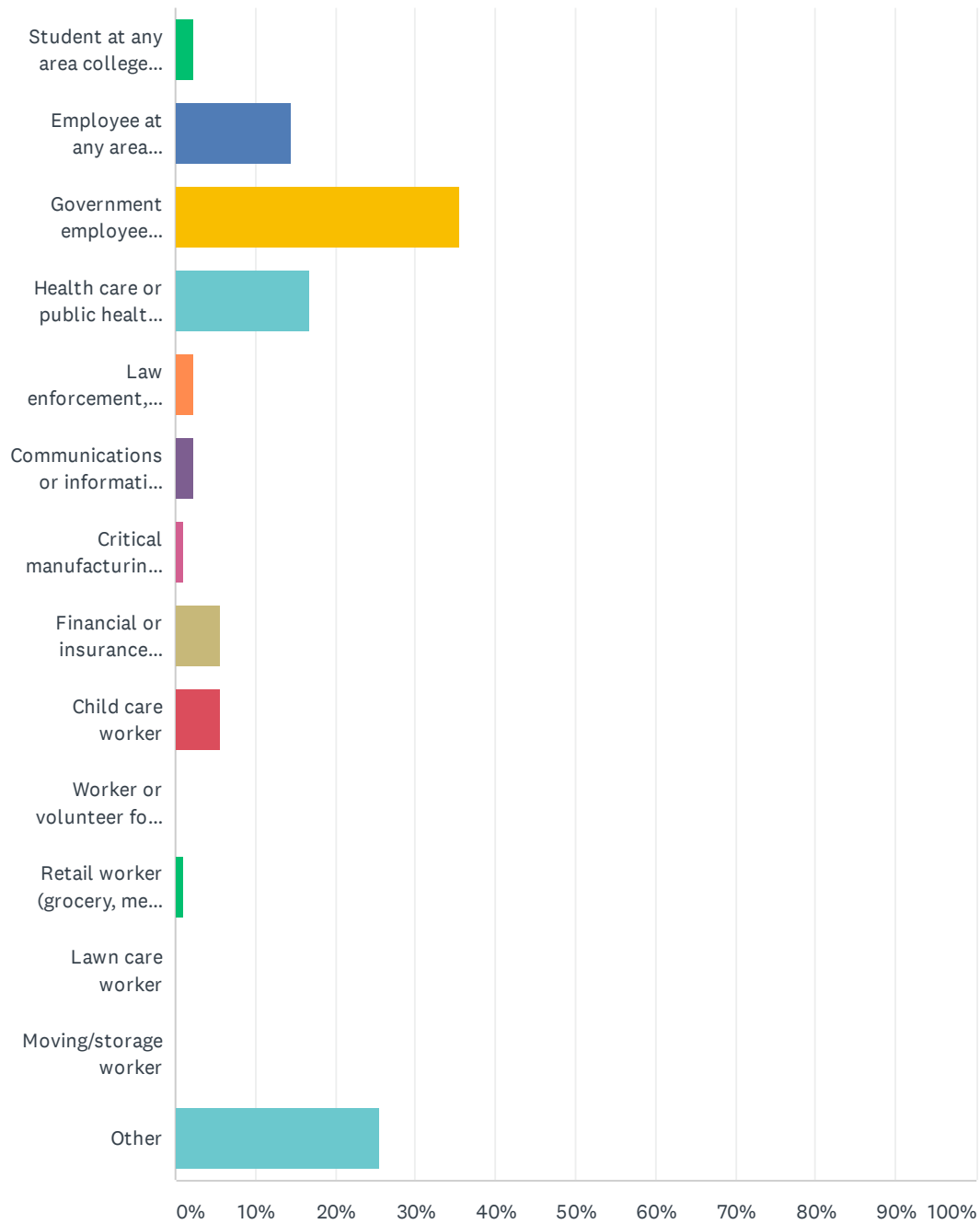


Q1 Please select the category(ies) that best describes your present occupation or vocation.

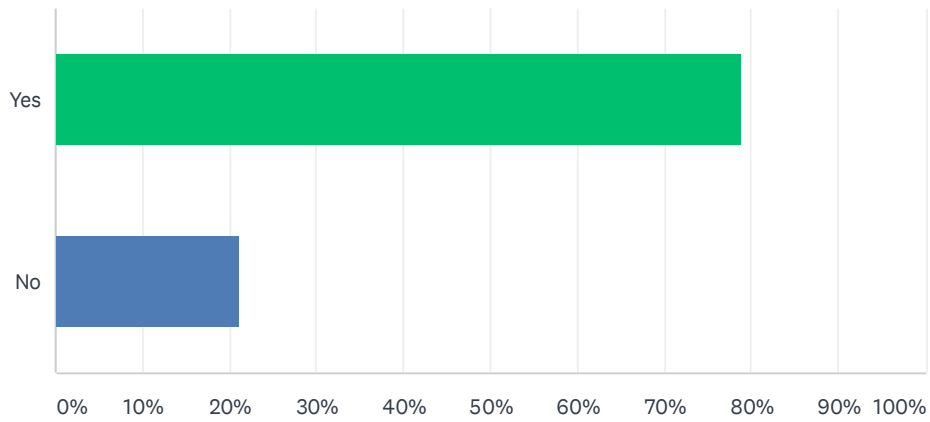

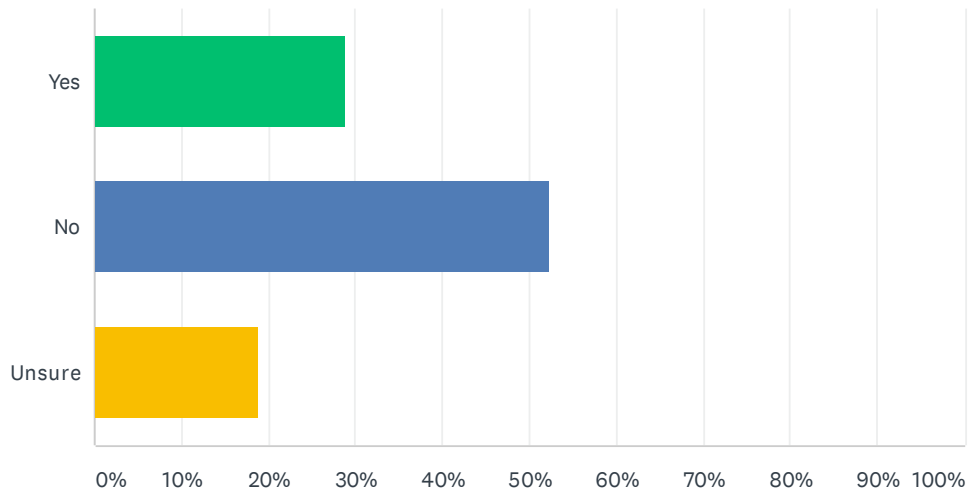

Q3 According to Executive Order 2020-59, are you considered a critical infrastructure worker, or a worker in any of the "resumed activities?"

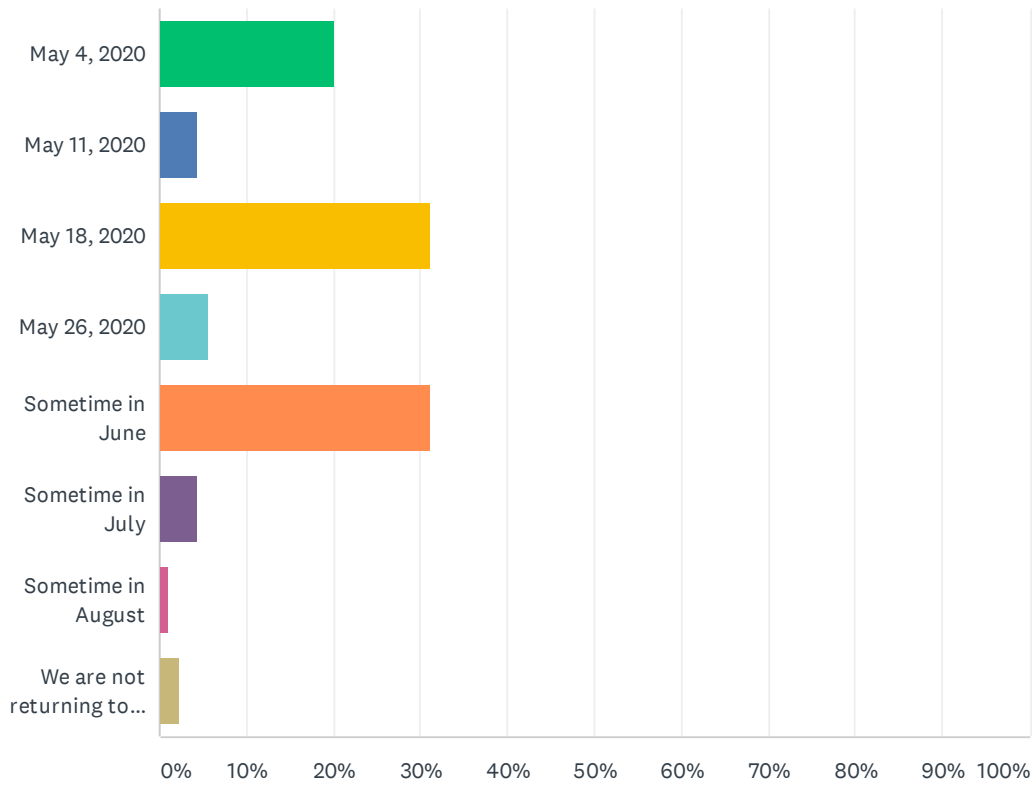

Q4 Please indicate the earliest date your child(ren) would return to EC3, when it resumes operations.

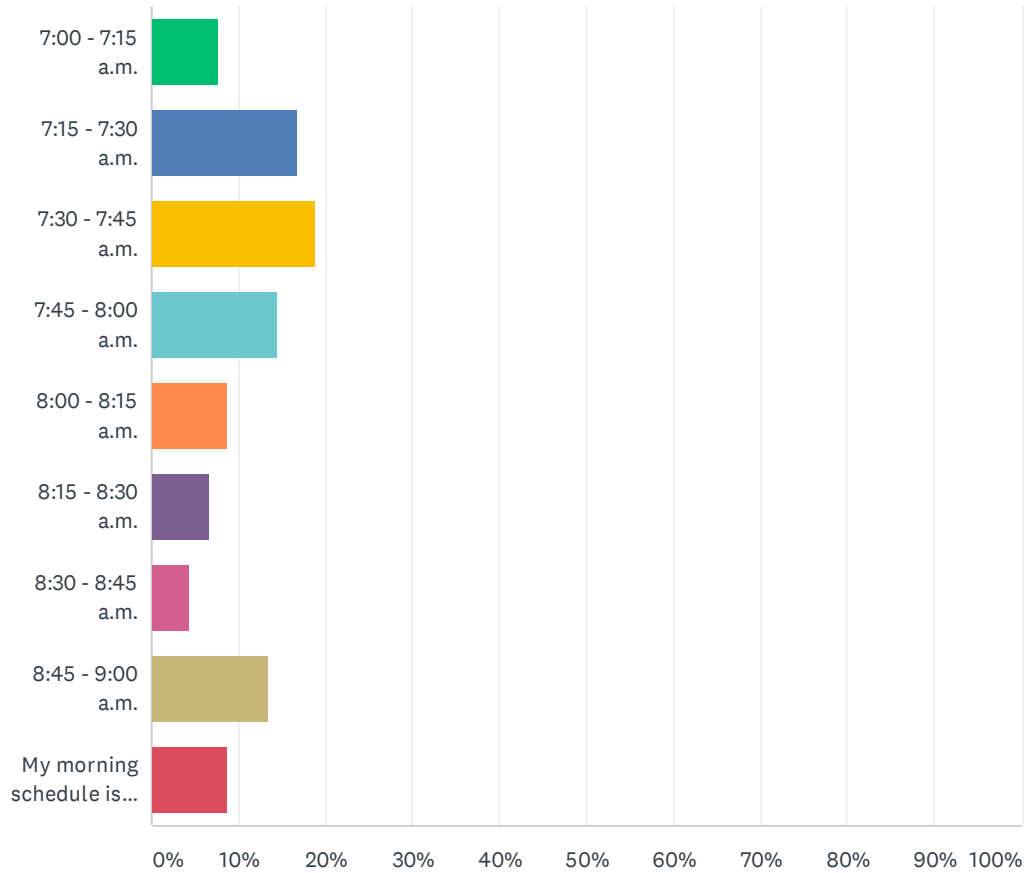

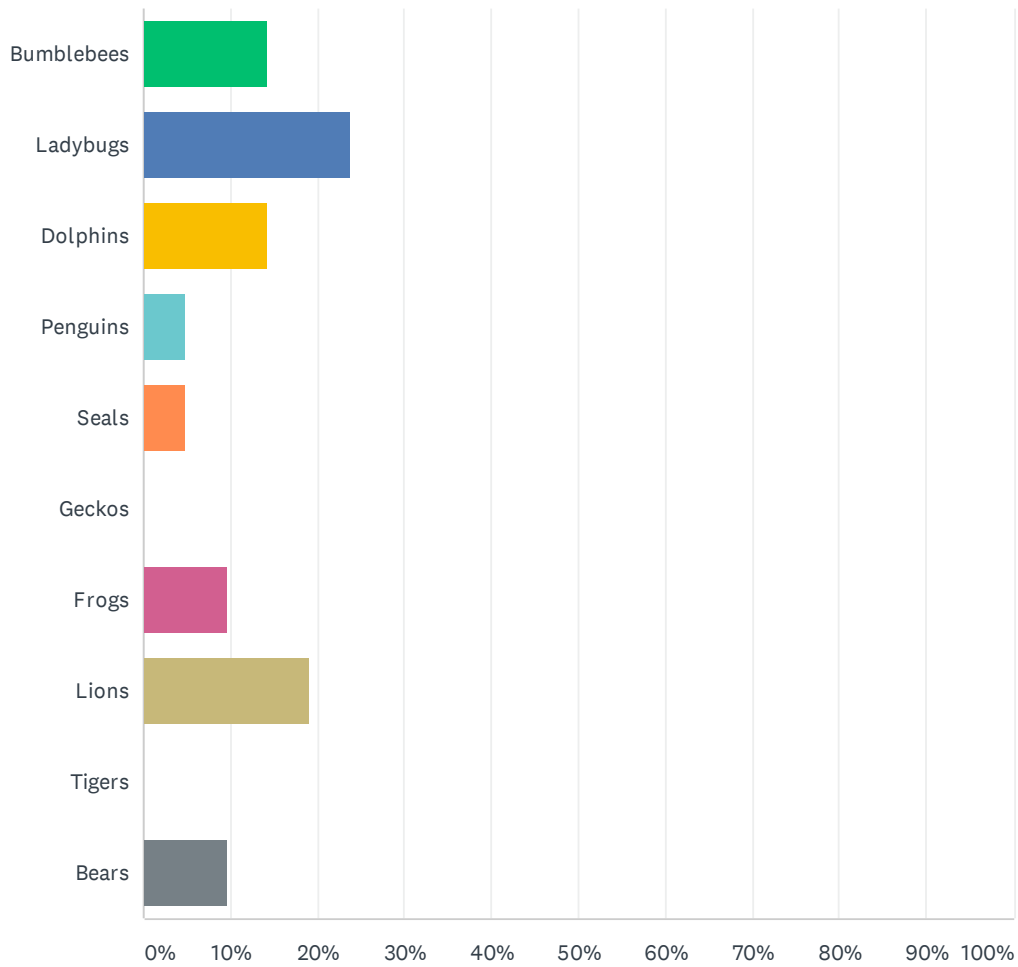
